

**The Anglican Church of Australia (ACC)**, formerly known as the Church of England in Australia, is an autonomous church of the Anglican Communion. It is the second largest church in Australia, after the Roman Catholic Church. According to the 2016 census, 3.1 million Australians identify as Anglicans. For much of Australian history the church was the largest religious denomination. It remains today one of the largest providers of social welfare services in Australia. Our service is from *An Order for the Holy Communion (2009)*. Its origins lie in requests for a service which, in comparison with those in regular use in the ACC is shorter, and more direct in structure. The motif of God's call to us runs as a thread through the service.

### PAVE THE WAY UPDATE

St. Mark's has awarded our paving contract to Coppertone Paving Ltd for \$41,245. To date we have raised \$41,000! The motion at the Special Vestry on April 12 allowed St. Mark's to sign a contract worth not more than \$60,000 which included contingencies for repairing the granular base below the asphalt and other issues which may be uncovered. When the asphalt is removed we will be able to determine how much gravel will be needed for repairing the granular base which will mean additional costs. Thanks to all who have contributed and if you have not done so, and would like to, there are pledge cards and envelopes at the back of the church.


